AMENDMENT No. 1

THIS Amendment No. 1 (this “Amendment”) to the Information Technology Agreement (“Agreement” or “Contract”) is made by and between the **Department of Information Technology** hereinafter referred to as the “Procuring Agency” and **Altura Communications Solutions**, hereinafter referred to as the “Contractor” and collectively referred to as the “Parties”.


The purpose of this amendment is to renew the agreement that expires on April 30, 2020 for four (4) additional years through April 30, 2024.

IT IS MUTUALLY AGREED BETWEEN THE PARTIES THAT THE FOLLOWING PROVISIONS OF THE AGREEMENT ARE AMENDED AS FOLLOWS:

1. **ARTICLE 5 – TERM.** THIS AGREEMENT SHALL NEITHER BE EFFECTIVE NOR BINDING UNTIL APPROVED BY THE DoIT AND THE STATE PURCHASING AGENT. This Agreement shall terminate on April 30, 2024 with no option to renew.

All other Articles of the original DoIT Price Agreement No. 70-361-17-02013AA remain unchanged.
